

INTRODUCTION

This booklet provides a guide of cultural funding opportunities for Dutch–Belgian cultural cooperation. It was created for the symposium *Entrepreneurship and Funding in the Dutch and Belgian Cultural Sector* on February 7, 2024, organised by the Embassy of the Kingdom of the Netherlands in Brussels in collaboration with DutchCulture, the Dutch network organisation for international cultural cooperation.

After an introduction by the Dutch Ambassador for International Cultural Cooperation, Dewi van de Weerd, researcher and publicist Renée Steenbergen guided the audience through the landscape of funding systems in the Netherlands, and the opportunities and pitfalls of public-private partnerships. For several decades, the Dutch cultural sector has been actively combining private and public resources with the aim to support artists and creatives.

The main objective of this booklet is to inform the Belgian and Dutch cultural sectors on funding bodies and programmes that support the cultural collaboration between Belgium and the Netherlands. The overview focuses on funding that stimulates:

- # cultural projects by Netherlands-based creatives taking place in Belgium;
- # cultural collaborations between the Netherlands and Belgium taking place in Belgium.

Important note: Some grants in this booklet are also available to organisations and creatives based in the Caribbean Netherlands. Oftentimes, more budget than indicated in this overview is available for cultural collaboration between the Caribbean Netherlands and Belgium, since for example travel costs are higher. Please check the website of the grant provider and scan the QR code of the particular grant for more information.

Internationalization of the Design Sector Grant Scheme

Open to projects by professional makers, spectators, design agencies, cultural institutions or organizations that are collaborating with one or more international partners and whose activities mainly take place abroad.

Sector

Design, architecture, digital culture and cross-overs

Who can apply?

Makers, institutions, organisations, and collectives based in the Kingdom of the Netherlands

For what?

The grant can be used for research, collaboration and project costs. There is also a starting grant available to investigate the possibilities for a larger project.

How much?

Regular project grant: no maximum Starting grant: a maximum of € 7.500

Europe + Heritage Support Grant Scheme

To promote the establishment of contacts with the Belgian/ European heritage sector and the exchange of knowledge between the Netherlands and Belgium/Europe.

Sector

Who can apply?

Heritage professionals, people working at heritage organisations or staff members of heritage departments of Dutch municipalities based in the Kingdom of the Netherlands

For what?

The grant can be used for projects and activities such as knowledge exchange, heritage-related events, meetings, conferences and symposiums. These exchanges are expected to contribute to fresh insights, durable relations and projects in the field of heritage.

How much?

Continuous (at least six weeks before the start of the project)

NTERNATIONAL HERITAGE COOPERATION MATCHING FUND

International Heritage Cooperation Matching Fund

Meant for projects that contribute to the visibility of the history and heritage that connects the Netherlands with other countries, such as Belgium.

Professionals and institutions in the fields of heritage and/or culture based in the Kingdom of the Netherlands

For what?

The grant can be used for travel, accommodation, communication and production costs, as well as sideprogrammes and publications.

How much?

A maximum of € 35.000

Who can apply?

Writers, poets, spoken word/slam artists, translators, illustrators or literary programmers/curators from Dutch-speaking regions.

For what?

The grant can be used for costs connected to meetings and workshops, and project costs.

How much?

A maximum of € 2.500 for individuals A maximum of € 10.000 for organisations

Euregio Scheldemond is the cross-border partnership between the provinces of East Flanders, West Flanders and Zeeland. The fund supports small-scale projects in various fields such as education, tourism, culture and heritage.

Sector

All, heritage

Who can apply?

Municipalities, organisations, foundations, schools, etc. based in East Flanders, West Flanders and/or Zeeland

For what?

The grant can be used for project costs.

How much?

100% of the (small-scale) project costs

Culture Moves Europe Individual Mobility Action

For artists and cultural professionals to carry out a project with a partner of their choice in a Creative Europe country (i.e. Belgium and the Netherlands). The goal is to explore, create, learn and connect.

Sector

Music, literature, architecture, cultural heritage, design and fashion design, visual arts and performing arts

Who can apply?

Netherlands and Belgium-based artists/cultural professionals who want to travel to another Creative Europe country, or to a partner to collaborate with on a project.

For what?

The grant can be used for travel and subsistence costs and offers additional top-ups based on grantees' individual situation. For an individual, the grant can last 7 to 60 days, whereas groups of up to 5 people can make use of the grant for 7 to 21 days.

How much?

A maximum of € 350 for a travel distance under 5000 km A maximum of € 700 for a travel distance above 5000 km A maximum of € 75 euros for daily allowance A maximum of € 10.000 euros for organisations

Possible top-ups: green mobility, family and disability

The grant can be used for project costs related to artistic research, experimentation and/or the realization of new work or an innovative initiative.

How much?

A maximum of € 7.500

The grant can be used for the costs of presentations at the fair including travel, accommodation, art transport and production costs for new work.

How much?

The total costs of transport, insuring the work, and travel and lodging expenses for the participating artists, plus a maximum of 50% of production costs for new work.

- # A maximum of 1.000 euros per person towards lodging
- # Transport and insurance expenses
- # A maximum of 50% of the production costs of new (site-specific) work commissioned by the non-Dutch art institution
- # A maximum of 25% of costs of the publication associated with the presentation
- # A maximum of 50% of the translation costs of subtitling a film

For what?

The grant can be used for travel and transportation costs.

Netherlands-based producing organisations such as a music theatre, theatre, dance company or ensemble. Festivals can also apply if they are involved in an artistic/substantive manner with the creation process of the proposed international co-production.

For what?

The grant can be used for personnel, preparation and implementation costs, and for marketing and publication costs.

How much?

A maximum of € 75.000


